PUBLIC NOTICE for unemployed persons interested in participating on a free nursing training for elderly and feeble persons

The goal of the training is acquiring professional care skills for elderly, as well as certification. *The training consists of theoretical, practical and onsite training for the following 6 issues:*

1. Home maintenance
2. Support in performing the everyday activities
3. Ergonomic principles
4. Elderly protection
5. Psycho-social support
6. Medical assignments

The training of nurses for elderly and feeble persons will be held in Macedonian language and will take place in the period from February 2013 to June 2013 in Skopje. Following the completion of the modules, the participants' acquired skills will be certificated.

In order to apply for training participation, the candidates should meet the following requirements:

- to be an adult person
- to be unemployed
- to have minimum elementary education
- to be psycho-physically fit
- to have desire and determination to work with elderly

Additional requirement for the selected candidates is to sign a personal statement that commits them to work in the home care service for elderly, managed by the Association Humanost.

During the training (4 months period), the selected participants will receive certain financial compensation in the amount of 60 euros or 3.690 MKD (gross amount) calculated by the average exchange rate of NBRM. The shortlisted candidates will be invited on an interview performed by a professional team.
